1. Vital signs per unit routine
2. Notify MD temp > 100.4, respiratory distress or other acute changes
3. Diet: regular for age unless otherwise specified
4. Tylenol 15 mg/Kg/dose q 4 hours PRN temp > 101
5. Motrin 10 mg/Kg/dose q 8 hours PRN temp >101 not relieved by Tylenol; if 6 months old or greater
<ul> <li>6. Obtain aerobic/anaerobic blood culture, cath UA and urine culture,</li> <li>□ CBC □ CBC with auto Diff □ CBC with manual Diff</li> <li>Consent for LP on all children &lt; 6 weeks old admitted with fever 101 unless otherwise specified.</li> </ul>
7. Obtain O2 Sat ASAP with respiratory distress and notify MD
8. Saline drops and bulb suction q 1 hour PRN for congestion
9. Bedside humidifier PRN
10. Old chart to floor
